Students train and certify in an industry specific field, obtain employment, map out a plan for advancement in their education and develop leadership qualities that will lead them to a bright future.

WIOA - This program is for youth between the ages of 18 and 24 who live in San Bernardino County, and is funded by the Federal Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA).

TANF - Career Institute contracts with the County Temporary Assistance for Needy Families Program providing occupational training in:

- ✓ Certified Nursing Assistant
- ✓ Truck Driving
- ✓ Vehicle Maintenance and Light Repair

CYEP - Cal WORKS Youth Employment Program (CYEP) places hard working employees with employers. Young Adults ages 18-24, work up to 40 hours per week to a total of 200 hours.

CSEP - The Cal WORKS Subsidized Employment Program matches hard working mature workers with employers. Adults ages 25 and up work up to 40 hours per week to a total of 485 hours.

HINKLEY - The Hinkley Program is focused on paid work experience and career development activities for young adults between the ages of 18 and 24 in the Hinkley community just outside of Barstow. Pacific Gas and Electric funds program participants to:

✓ Work in a paid work experience for 40 hours a week for 12 weeks
✓ Training in career, education and life planning
